What to Expect:

Over 3 immersive days, you'll experience a blend of guided workshops, independent creative time, and restorative leisure in breathtaking surroundings.

- Four guided workshops (2 hours each) combining group and individual work
- Collaborative and independent creative time
- Evening saunas and accommodations at The Vaihela archipelago hotel
- Welcome dinner to kick-off the retreat
- Transportation to/from Turku train station to the island

Workshops will draw from visual arts, sound, creative writing, and movement, offering multiple entry points into creative expression. The approach is research-based, inspired by the Creative Methodologies Course developed at the University of Helsinki Doctoral School (2022-2024).

The retreat welcomes anyone who wishes to:

- Engage the full range of sensory experience in creative work.
- Develop or refine a project (writing, painting, music, or personal inquiry)
- Receive supportive feedback and inspiration in a nurturing environment.
- Looking for a creative escape into nature

Sessions will be held in English or bilingually in English and Finnish, depending on participants' preferences.

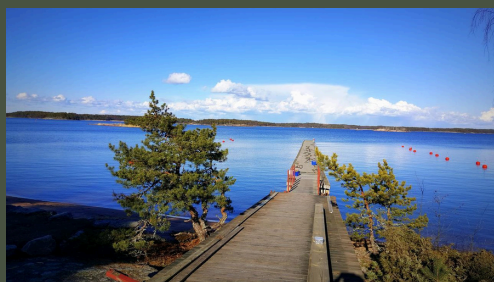

What's Included with Registration fees?

- 4 Workshop sessions: Creative workshop themes include sonic, visual, movement, and creative writing.
- Accommodations: 3-night stay (breakfast included) at Vaihela archipelago Hotel.
- Welcome dinner and drinks: Held the evening of June 4th. Three-course meal with wine package pairing.
- Supplies: We provide all artmaking materials required for the workshops.
- Facilities: Access to 1 hr evening saunas on 5th and 6th June.
- Supportive Environment: A safe, inspiring atmosphere encouraging creativity, play and self-expression.
- Transportation to and from Vaihela from Turku Train Station on June 4th and June 7th. Pick-up at 14:00 on 4th June and drop-off at 12:00 on 7th June.

What's NOT Included with Registration fees?

- Flights or Train Travel to Turku: Participants are responsible for arranging their own flights or other forms of transportation to Turku Train Station. The retreat pickup is at 14:00 on 4th June from Turku Train Station.

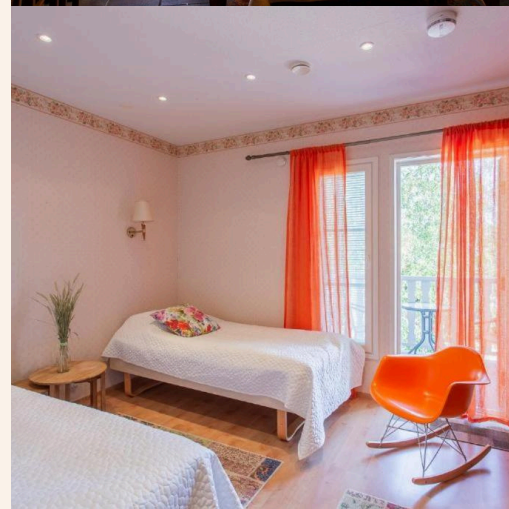
